HMDC Cavaletti Clinic with **Barbara Bell** — Saturday-Sunday, April 1-2, 2023

Guess what?! Dressage training can be more than going around in 20-meter circles trying to get your horse “round” and learning to sit the trot! Work over cavaletti and ground poles, (mostly at walk and trot), will help your horse develop pushing power, add variety to your training program, and it’s great FUN, especially when you have ground people to set up and move the poles while you catch your breath on your horse!

HMDC is offering a 2-day Clinic with local instructor, and USDF “L” program graduate, Barbara Bell, to introduce cavaletti work for some and reinforce its benefits for others. Cavaletti sessions will be group lessons (2-4 riders) and will last about 1 hour. Cost is \$35 per rider/horse combination.

The clinic will be held at Lou Kennedy’s indoor arena north of Lovell. Call Barbie at 307-548-7079 with any questions.

DIRECTIONS to the facility:

From Cody & Powell follow 14A heading East. Stay on 14A through Lovell (left turn as you leave town) — go about 2 miles to County Road 37 — turn left heading north (you’ll pass the CETCO bentonite plant). Between mile markers 8 and 9 look for a dirt road on left (you’ll see a tan “sugarcube” building near the turnoff). Turn left — house and arena are about 1 1/2 miles down on the right. (You can’t miss it! — don’t panic — it looks like there’s nothing there until you turn the corner!) Please pull counter-clockwise around the arena and park on the east side or behind the house.

We are curious to know if some of you would like a cavaletti setup combined with small jumps. Check the box on the entry form if so.
